CORPORATE WORSHIP

Why do we use this term? Why don't we say, "We're going to church"?

The church is not a place. It is a living, breathing people. Us. We are the church!

We are a people who gather weekly to worship the One True, Living, and Triune God. We value this time greatly and want to speak of it accurately. Corporate worship is the weekly gathering of those who love Christ and one of the means that He uses to draw people to Himself.

Our weekly corporate worship services have four main elements:

- **Expository Preaching:** Preaching is the most essential part of why we meet (Acts 10:42). It is the means of learning more about God and His character. This is important because it provides guidance for daily obedience. We preach in an expository fashion, verse-by-verse, to incorporate the whole Bible in context. Expository Preaching
- **Worship in Song:** This is the time when we sing true things about God back to God. Every song we sing, from traditional hymns to contemporary choruses, is rooted in God's Word. Each week we maintain continuity between the content of the sermon and the songs we sing.
- **Worship in Giving:** We consider it an act of worship to give back to God a portion of the provision He has given us. Taking the Lord's Supper
- **Taking the Lord's Supper:** The supper is a weekly reminder of our covenant with Christ and with each other. It also directs us to enjoy what Christ has accomplished through the finished work of the cross. The supper is for those who are trusting in Christ.
