## **KidsPoint Ministry**



Our goal is to point our children to Christ through Scripture. We equip families with resources to engage each week's story and have intentional conversations about a GOOD, GRACIOUS, LOVING, SOVEREIGN, HOLY & MERCIFUL GOD!

Our children's ministry, KidsPoint, serves children from birth through 6th grade. ## **Newborns - Toddlers**

Nursery care for babies from birth through walkers is lovingly provided on Sunday morning during both hours of corporate worship. Toddlers engage the curriculum through art, music, drama, and more! They learn a story each week and make connections to Christ as they play, sing and memorize scripture.

## PreK - Kindergarten

Classes for PreK and kindergarten are provided on Sunday morning during both hours of corporate worship. The PreK and kindergarten children engage The Gospel Project curriculum through play, music, arts & crafts, and more! They learn scripture in a 3-year chronological study of the Old Testament and New Testament. On the last Sunday of each month, all of our PreK and kindergarten children join their family in corporate worship. ## 1st Grade - 6th Grade

On Sunday morning, all children in 1st grade and older will join their family in corporate worship during one of our two worship services. Our hope is that as they worship alongside us, our children will learn to have an appetite for the preached word and fellowship with God's people. We also offer Sunday school classes for elementary students to engage scripture in a 3-year chronological study of the Old Testament and New Testament using curriculum from The Gospel Project. They will make connections to Christ in every lesson through story, song, art, games and activities. Our aim is to nurture intentional worshippers by looking at the beauty of Christ in the stories of Creation

through the return of Christ.
